

## Middleton to Elect Delegates to Democratic State Convention

Democrats in Middleton will be holding a caucus on Sunday, June 2, 2019 in the Trustees' Room of the Flint Public Library, 1 South Main Street , Middleton. Sign-in for the caucus begins at 2:00 pm. Parking is available behind the library.

Elections will be held for delegates and alternates to the Massachusetts Democratic State Convention on Saturday, September 14 at the MassMutual Center in Springfield, MA.

There is no party registration deadline for caucuses in Massachusetts; the caucus is open to all registered and pre-registered Democrats in Middleton. People can register before caucus day ( June 2) and even at the caucus day to participate in voting and meeting business. However, it is strongly recommended that people register ahead of time at the Middleton Town Hall.

Pre-registered Democrats who will be 16 years old by May 11, 2019 will be eligible to run as a delegate or alternate. Middleton can elect four delegates, including the Chair, and three alternates.

Those not elected as a delegate or alternate may apply to be an "Add-on" candidate if eligible in one of the following diversity categories: Disabled, Minority, Youth, or LGBTQ. Applications can take place at the caucus or on-line at [www.massdems.org](http://www.massdems.org)

Discrimination on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, color, national origin, disability, religion, ethnic identity, or economic status is strictly prohibited in the conduct of the caucus.
