

WHAT TO BRING: Medical sharps (but not old medicine) such as needles and syringes, household hazardous waste no longer needed, up to 25 gallons of liquid chemicals or 25 pounds of dry chemicals, kept in original, sealed and labeled container with screw cap if possible, i.e.:

paints: oil-based only, consolidate
gas cylinders - propane**, helium**

cleaners: oven, toilet bowl, drain

corrosives, degreasers

polishes: furniture, floor

resins & adhesives

poisons, pesticides, insecticides

herbicides, fertilizers, fungicides

mercury: fluorescent bulbs, thermometers

waste fuels: kerosene, gasoline

spot removers

solvents, stains

photo chemicals

anti-freeze

swimming pool chemicals
