TOWN ELECTION & ANNUAL TOWN MEETING



The **Town Clerk's Office** has been very busy preparing for Saturday's Town Election (6/20/2020 from 10:00 a.m. to 4 p.m.) at the Fuller Meadow School. Additionally, they have been preparing for the upcoming Annual Town Meeting on Wednesday June 24th at the Howe-Manning School (7 p.m.). The Town Clerk's office, Town Management, School Facilities Staff, and the Town Moderator have prepared an excellent and safe voting and town meeting process for Middleton Residents in order to protect the safety and well being of voters and the election staff during this pandemic. Here are some guidelines and protocols they have put in place:

When you arrive, you are highly encouraged to wear a facial covering to protect yourself and others.

Everyone will be required to maintain 6 foot social/physical distance (unless same household). Markings will be evident to help remind people to maintain this distance. Seats will be placed with appropriate distance to one another (town mtg). There will be separate entrances and exits which will be clearly marked.

For elections, each voting booth will be cleaned and sanitized after each person casts his/her ballot.

For Town Meeting, each resident who decides to speak at the microphone, a one time use microphone cover will be put in place and replaced between each speaking engagement.

Hand Sanitizer will be available in certain areas. If you forgot your facial covering, please ask a staff person/volunteer and one can be provided (while supplies last). **KUDOS TO ALL THOSE INVOLVED IN THIS PLANNING**
